









FRONT UI VIEW





PRE-AMPLIFIER













MUTE SENSOR

- · If using, attach the mute sensor to the active lead of the electrocautery/diathermy device
- · Plug the mute sensor cable into the socket on the rear of the touch screen DCU MUTE (right).
- · Do not connect the mute sensor to the nerve monitor without attaching the clamp to the electrocautery cable or spurious muting of the nerve monitor may occur.





STIMULATOR POD















QUICK START SESSION (DEFAULT)





- Select **Default** and press
- Select a surgery procedure and press
- Press Ω to check the electrode impedance.

All indicators should show green. If not, check/reposition the electrodes (refer to "impedance check" in the user manual for more information).

- Drape the patient
- Press to begin monitoring
- · Press to end monitoring

Note: In default mode, procedure settings can be altered via the monitoring menu but the settings cannot be saved.

Patient Reports

Patient reports are not available in the default profile. In order to save patient reports you must create a surgeon profile (see advanced features). A surgeon profile will also allow you to save your custom procedure settings.











ACTIVE MONITORING SCREEN

STIMULATOR ADJUST

- The **stimulator current** is displayed at the bottom of the 'active monitoring screen'. Set the stimulator current using the left stimulator dial.
- When the Stimulator Probe is used, the stimulator indicator should change to green (as below):



 If the stimulator indicator does not change colour, the probe has not stimulated at the set current (refer to "Troubleshooting" in the User Manual for more information).

VOLUME CONTROLS

- The master volume is shown in the middle at the bottom of the 'active monitoring screen'. Set the master volume using the central master volume dial.
- To mute all channels temporarily, press and hold the master volume dial for 2 seconds. The master volume display will then show the following:



 The individual channel volume is shown in the top right of each channel window. You can change the individual channel volume by pressing it.

ADVANCED FEATURES

Custom surgeon profiles

To save patient reports and store your settings, you must create a password protected surgeon profile by pressing .

Custom procedures

You can save customised procedure settings for future use. Press to duplicate a default procedure and then press to edit it. Once you have finished making changes press to continue (not available in default mode).

Patient reports

Note: Not available in default mode. To save and access patient reports, patient details **must** be entered when prompted.

From the home screen press to access the **Report**Management Screen. Press to view the selected report.

Settings

From the **Home Screen**, press **O** to access the Settings menu.
